ROLE OF NEXT STEPS

- Linkage between Housing strategy and DOE
- Paving the pathway for support organisations
- Process still done through DOE and Approved housing Agency

HOUSING PROCESS

- Complete Application to Local Authority.
- Approval from DOE
- Tender any additional works
- Tender process must be transparent
- Need Engineer, Schedule of Works, Tenders, Time lines, Agreements with funders and Sign off

HOUSING PROCESS

- Placement of Residents (physical transition) but also funding issues
- Local Authority Housing List, Approval
- Placement agreement with Local Authority
- Rent Supplement, Rent Allowance ?
- Role of Community Welfare Officer V Role of Housing Officer of Local Authority
- Payment of rents while on DA

IMPORTANCE OF LOCAL LINKAGES IN HOUSING PROCESS


