## Your Pension Fund – On the go!

Members now have immediate access to their Pension Fund by accessing their Irish Life online <u>'Member Portal</u>', similar to the way a member reviews their bank balance online.

The <u>Member Portal</u> allows you to:

- Review your personal contact information.
- Check your current pension fund value.
- Review your investment choice.
- Check out the projections tool which is a great help for targeting the income level you want to have at retirement.
- Carry out an investment fund switch.
- Update your beneficiary details in the event of your death.
- View your Document Library which will in time contain all letters and correspondence sent to you from Irish Life.

To access your pension information online and at any time that suits you, you need to register for the online <u>Member Portal</u>. If you have already given Irish Life your email address or mobile phone number, you can register now and get access to your <u>online pension account</u>.

If you have not already provided your personal details to Irish Life the above link will not work for you. To get access please email <u>fedvol@irishlife.ie</u> with the following details:

Your Name and address; Employer Name; Date of Birth; mobile number and your personal email address and ask Irish Life to provide you with a link to access your pension member portal.

Once you have registered for the Member Portal, as outlined above, you can then download the "Irish Life EMPOWER" app on your mobile phone. iPhone users can go to the Apple Store to download the app. Android users can download the app from the Google Play Store.
