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RESTRICTIVE PRACTICE POLICY

OBJECTIVE:

The purpose of this Policy is to provide residents and staff of the MooreHaven Centre Residential Homes with guidelines regarding restrictive procedures.

RESPONSIBILITY

The review of this Policy document lies with the management team. The day to day implementation rests with the PIC and residential staff.

POLICY DETAILS

The MooreHaven Centre will actively follow the Health Information and Quality Authority document "Restrictive Procedures, November 2013 in this respect, a copy of which is attached to this Policy.

N.B.

Regarding current situation:

1. Monitor put in place in consultation with resident, his sister and Residential Staff. Procedure was explained and use of monitor was demonstrated to resident before he consented to use, 14/03/2014.
2. Only the residential staff member on duty will be in the position to listen to monitor.
3. A fold bed alarm which is designed to detect seizures connected to an alarm monitoring centre continues to be place. However this residents' type of seizure has changed and this system does not always alert the residential staff
4. A risk assessment has been done on the situation and the requirement for using a baby monitor device has been signed by the resident in question giving consent for its use.

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
