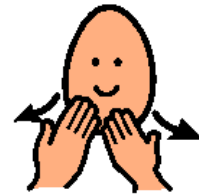


## Inclusive Research Workshop (Galway) - 17 November 2008

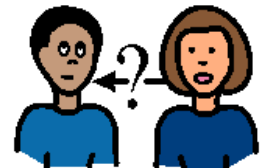
The Day started with everyone introducing each other as there were some new people that were not at the last workshop.
