
Self-injurious behaviour

My Self Injurious Behaviour




 Ingesting inanimate objects e.g. lids of bottles, batteries, cigarette lighters, can pull rings etc.



































Number of in-hospital inpatient nights v Community Home overnights in Avaion House Jan-Dec 2007 (12 months)

- ■Jan-Dec 07 In patient Overnight Stays




Number of In-hospital Inpatient nights v Community Home overnights Jan-Dec 2008 (12 months)







No. of In-Hospital In-Patient Nights v Community Home Overnights Jan - Dec 2009 (12 months)


What has this meant for Anne

She has re established past friendships




