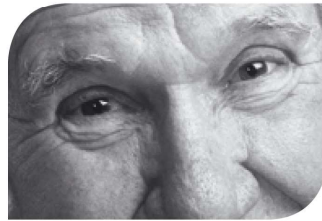

## ☞ Data collected includes:

- ☞ Personal details (including name and address, age, level of I.D., next of kin etc)
- ☞ Current day and residential service use
- ☞ Future day and residential service need
- ☞ Current and future multidisciplinary supports



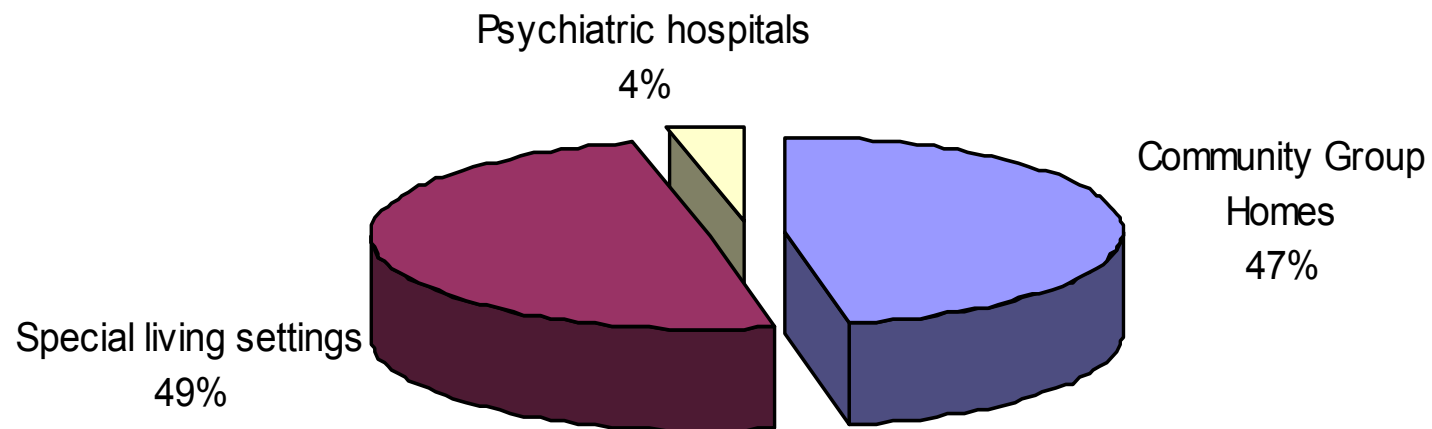
# Overview of residential care NIDD 2008 (n=26,023)



At home	16,708 (64.2%)
In full time residential services	8,290 (31.9%)
Live independently/ semi independently	950 (3.7%)



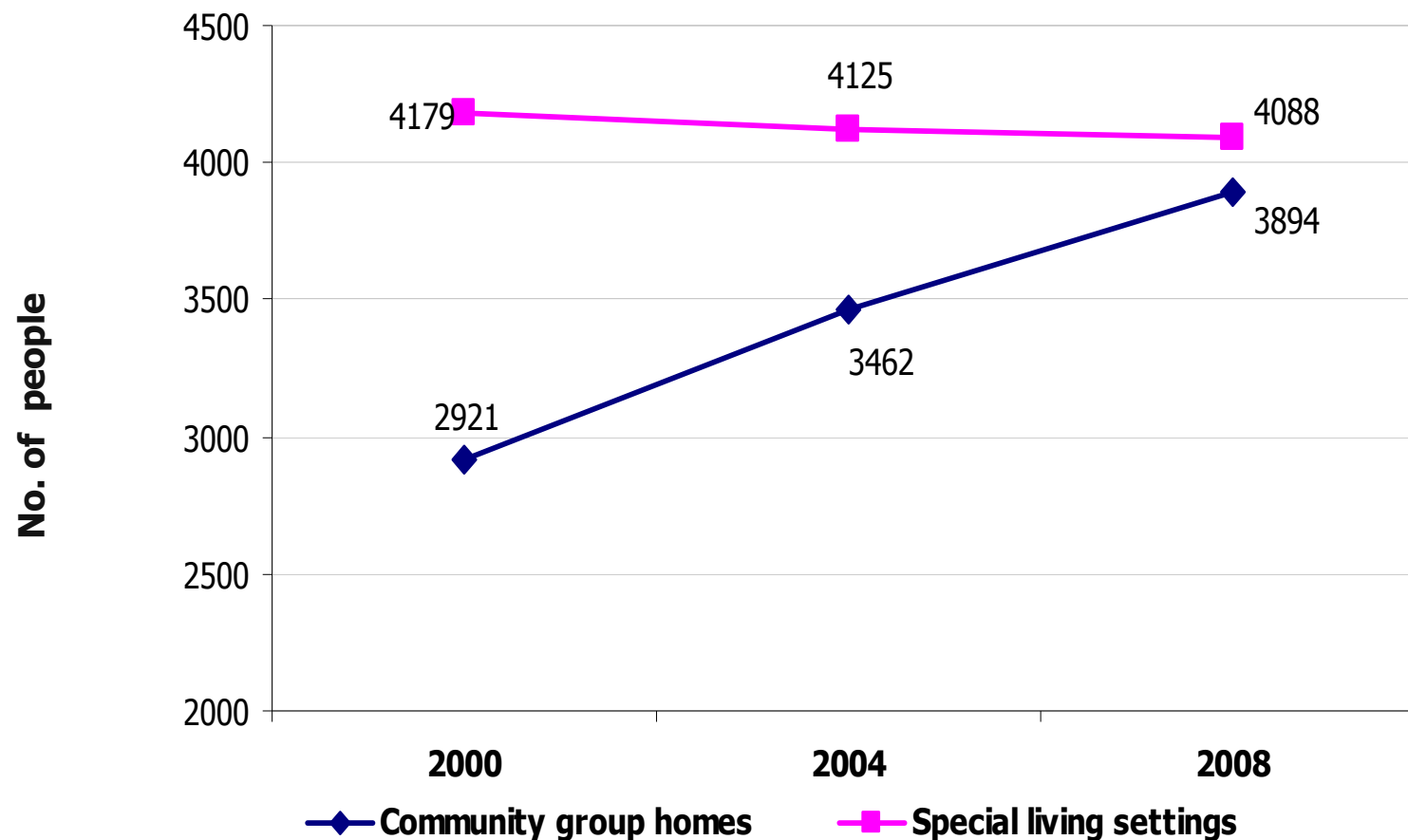
# Residential service NIDD 2008 (n=8,290)

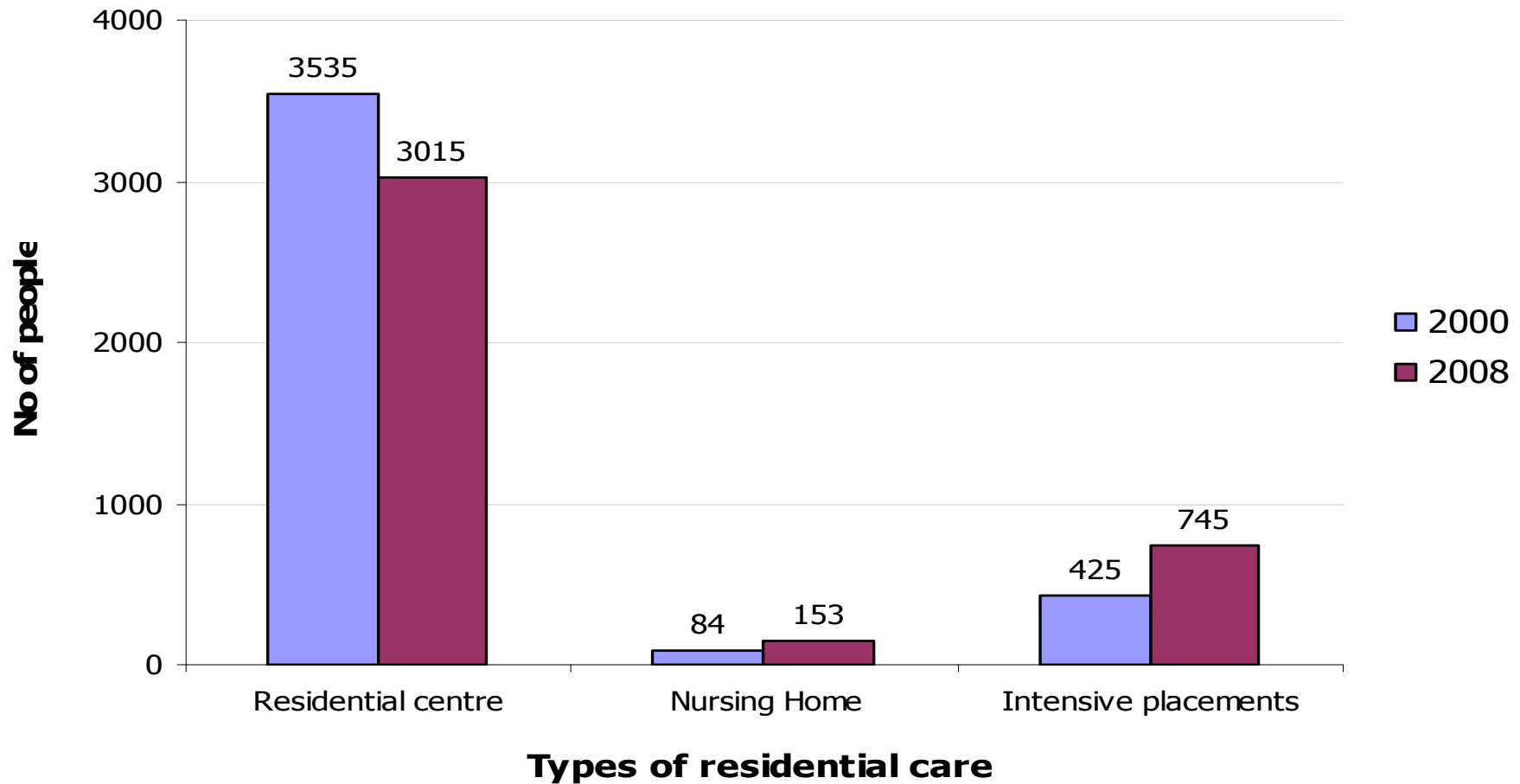

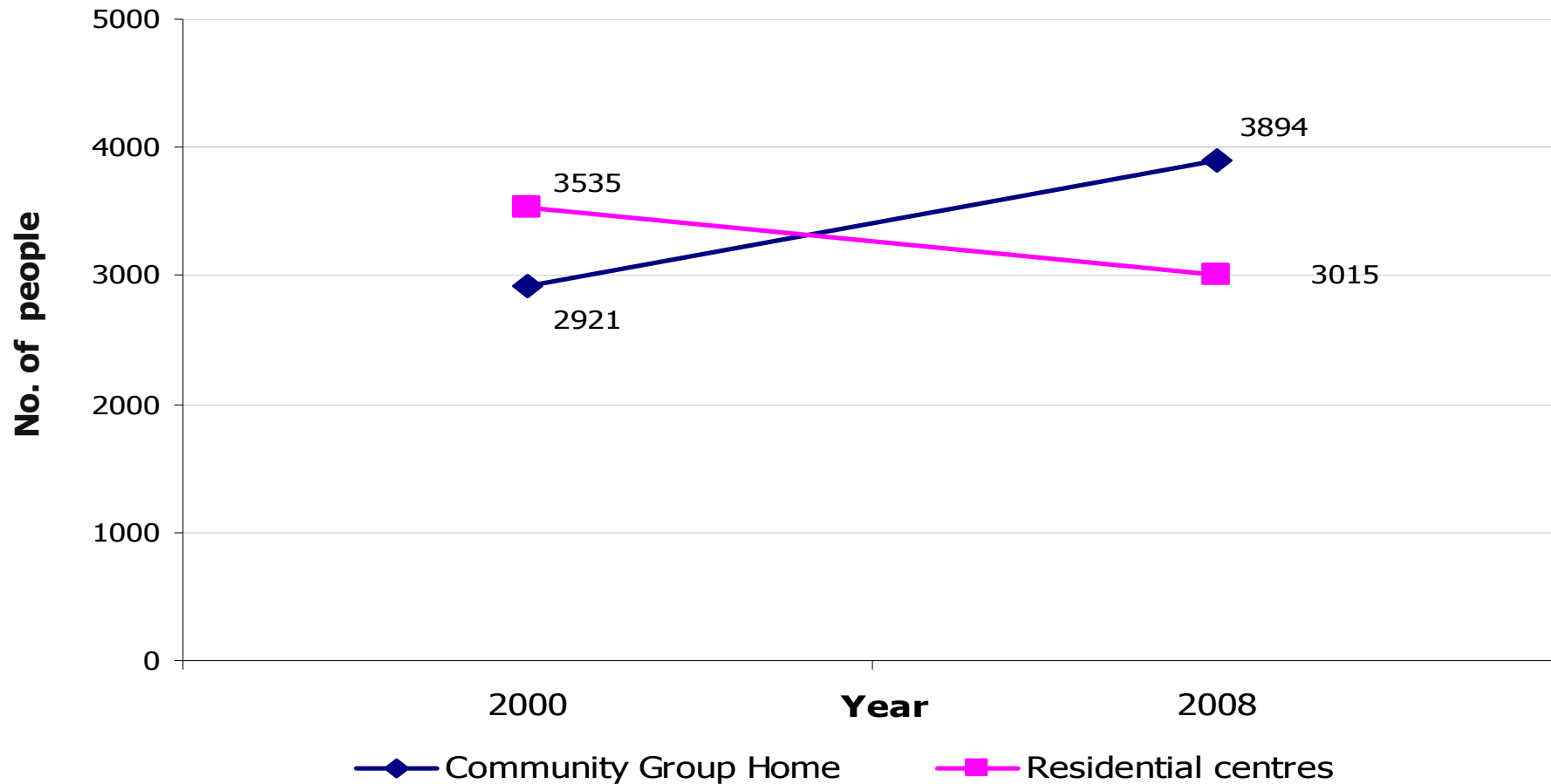

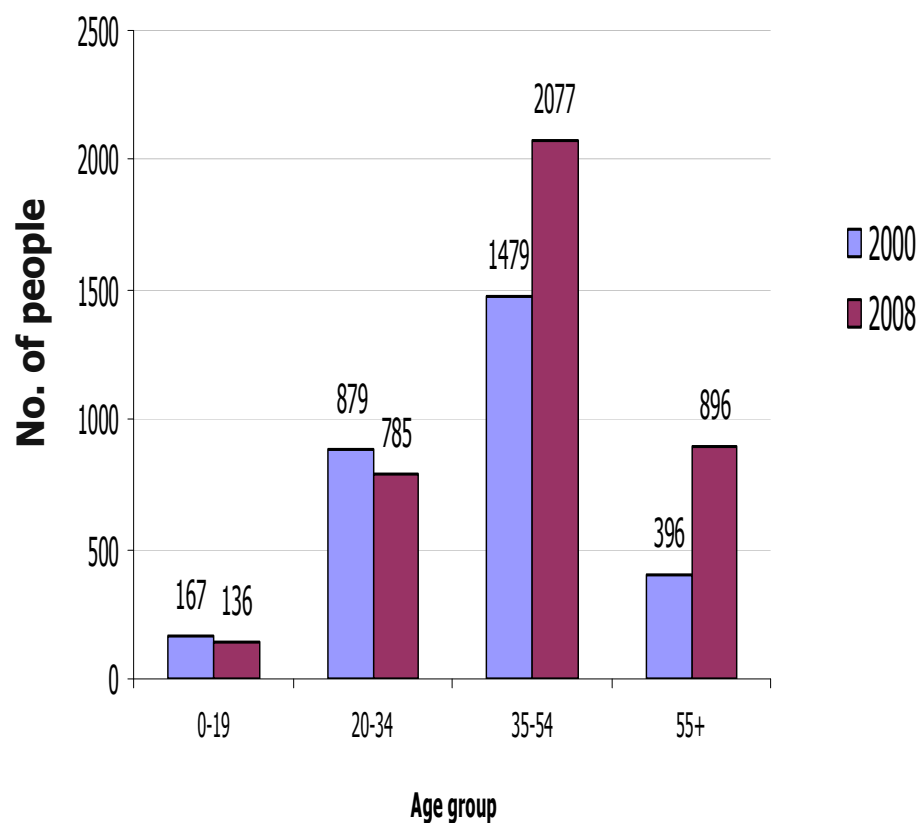
# Residential care setting – age profile



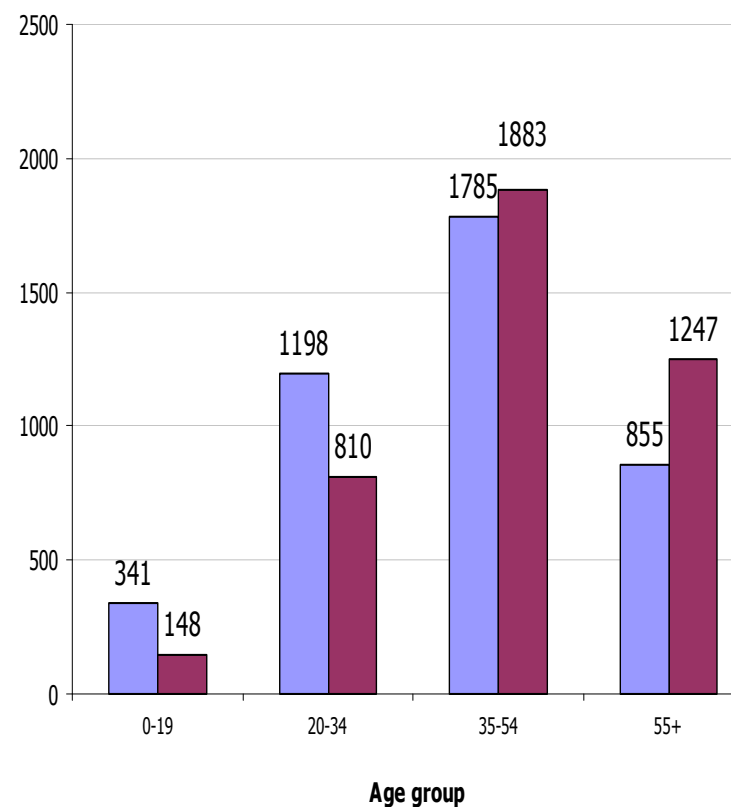
# Age group and residential care setting, NIDD 2000 & 2008

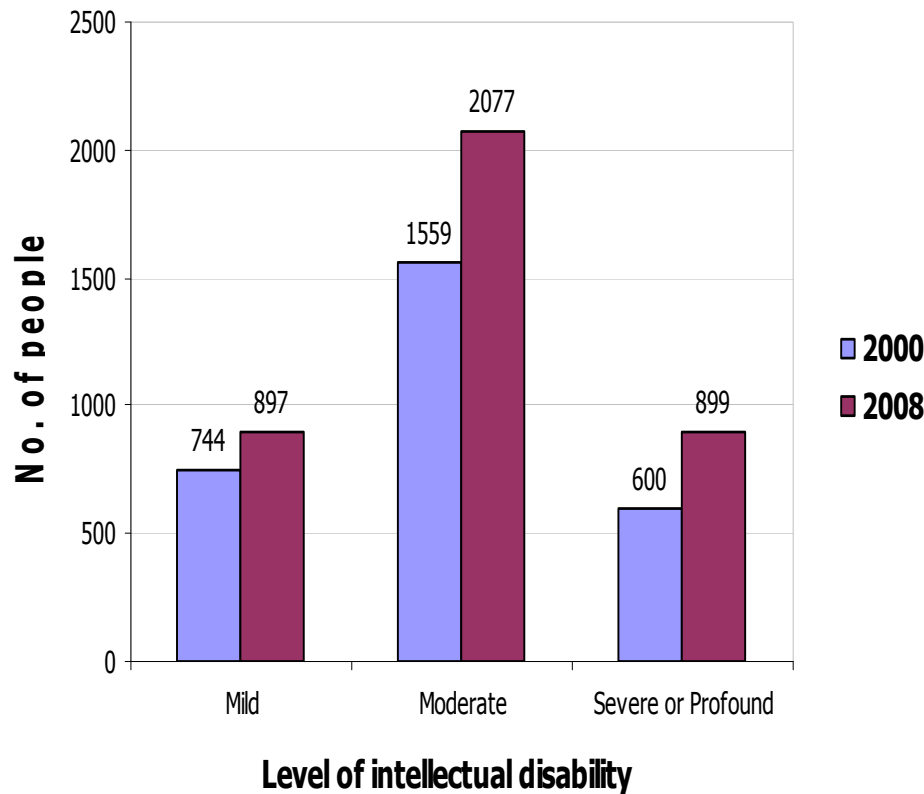
# **Disability and residential care setting NIDD 2000-2008**



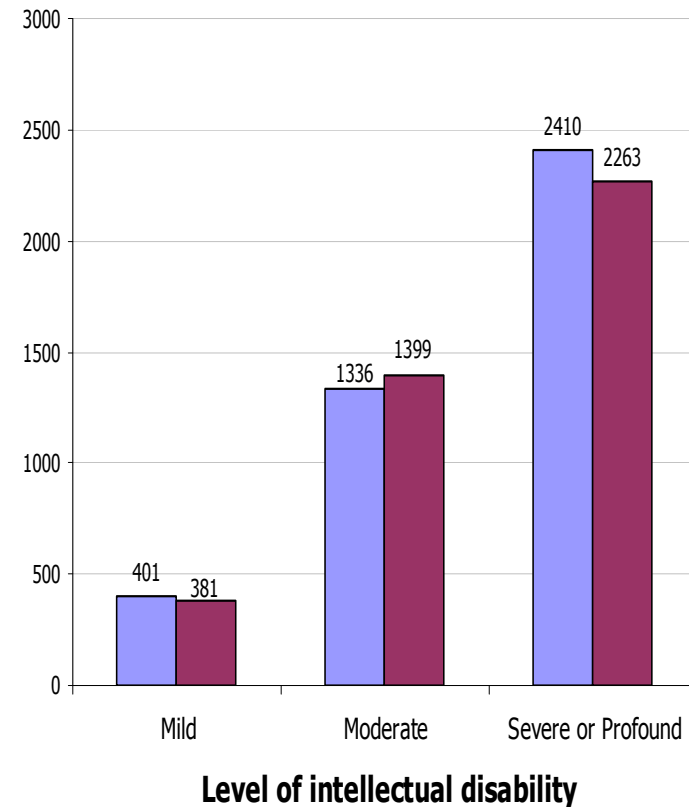
# Residential care setting and level of intellectual disability NIDD 2000 & 2008



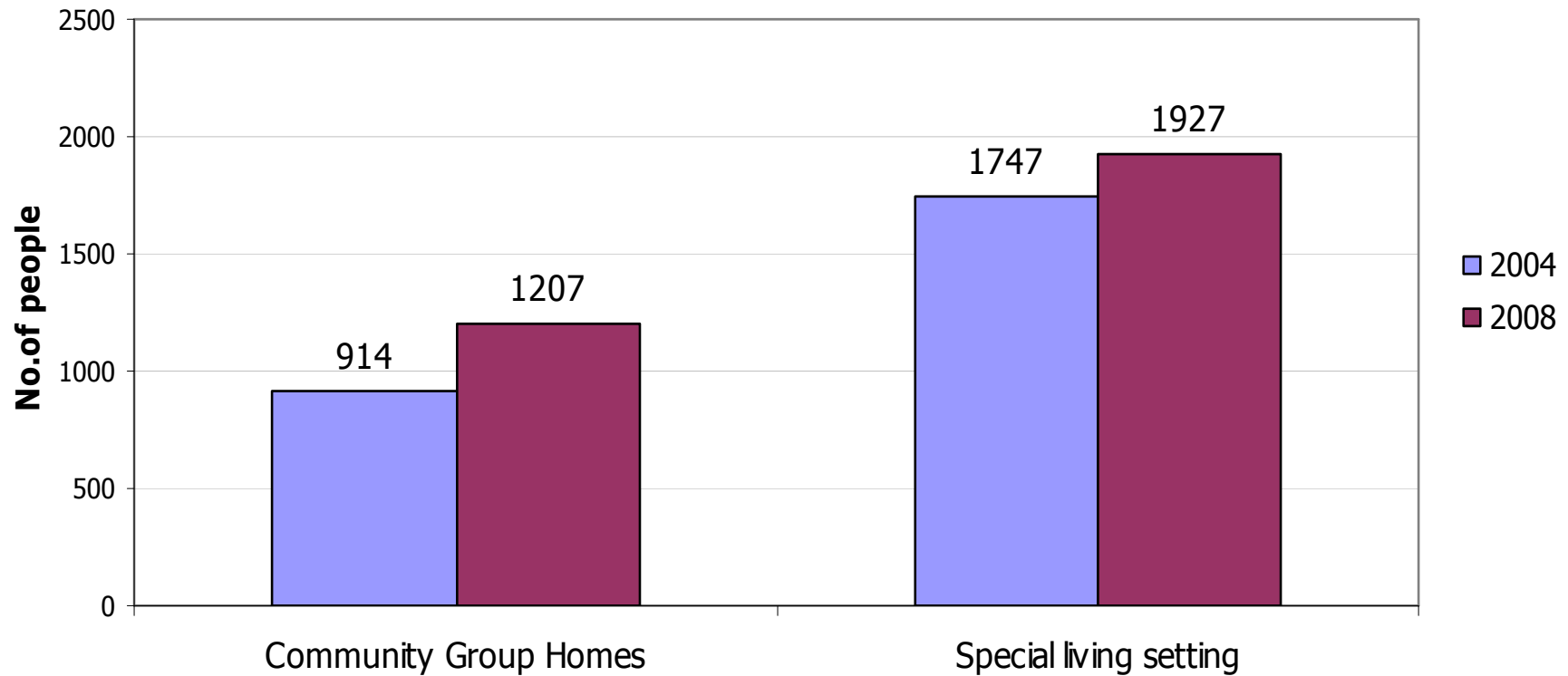

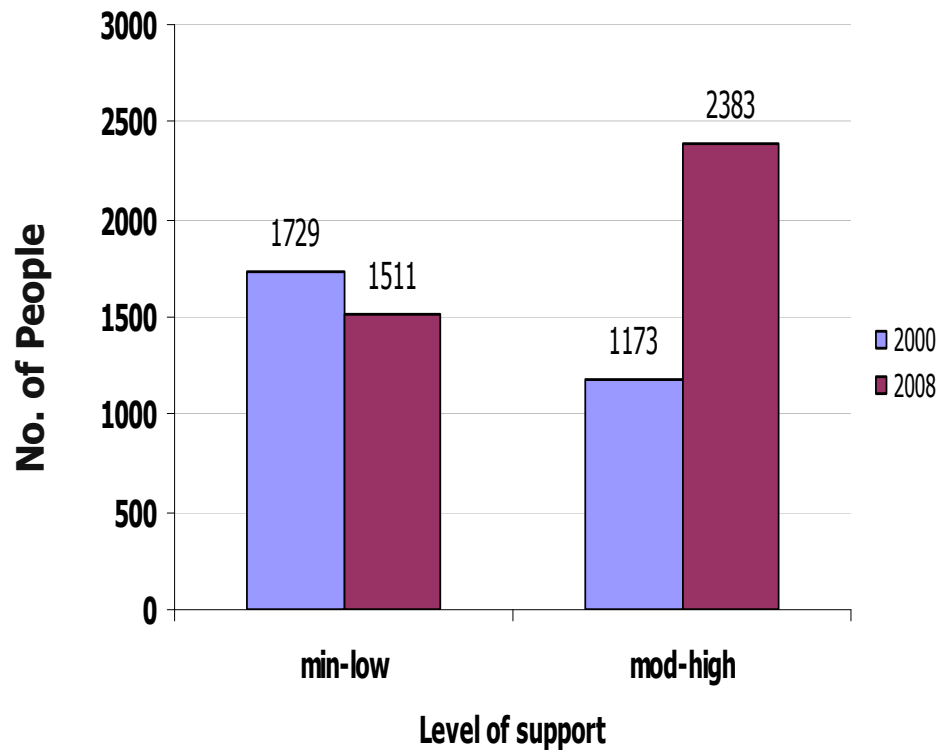




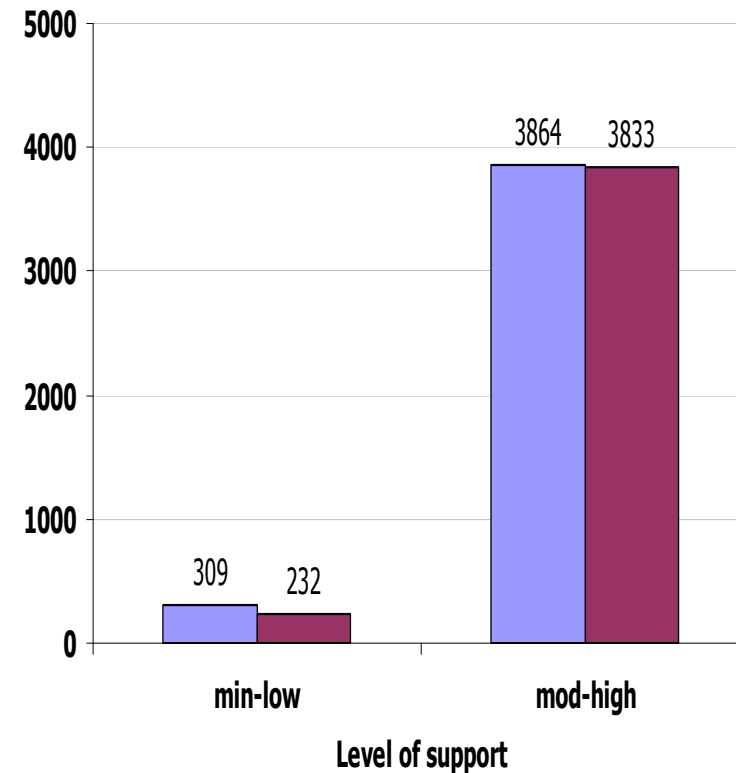
# Level of residential supports NIDD 2000 & 2008

# Current residential circumstance of those living at home in 2000 (n=10,680)



<b>Residential circumstance 2008</b>	<b>%</b>
Still in home setting	83.4
Independent/semi-independent setting	3.1
Community Group Homes	9.0
Residential Centres	2.1
Other residential services	2.4



# Current residential circumstances of those living in residential centres in 2000 (n=2,848)



<b>Residential circumstance 2008</b>	<b>%</b>
Still in residential setting	79.2
Home setting	0.8
Community Group Homes	12.4
Independent/semi independent	0.4
Other residential services	7.2



# Current residential circumstances of those living independently/semi independently in 2000 (n=366)



<b>Residential circumstance 2008</b>	<b>%</b>
Still in independent/semi independent setting	74.0
Home setting	7.7
Community Group Homes	10.4
Residential centres	2.5
Other residential services	5.2
